



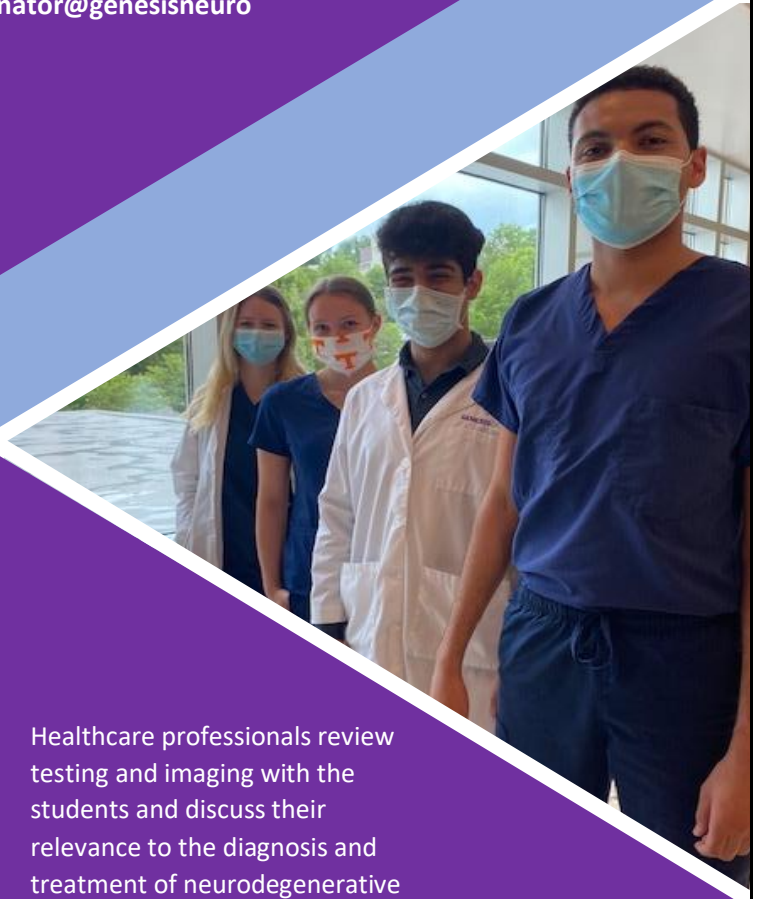

Volunteer interns play an integral role in the neurocognitive evaluation of each patient. This program provides interns with the opportunity to participate in hands-on learning while assisting the region's healthcare experts in a spectrum of neurocognitive disorders.

Volunteers receive specialized training in administering and grading an array of neurocognitive tests used to diagnose and treat various forms of dementia.

Interns get to work directly with patients and their families to administer tests like the Mini-Mental State Examination and Montreal Cognitive Assessment (MoCA).



Healthcare professionals review testing and imaging with the students and discuss their relevance to the diagnosis and treatment of neurodegenerative diseases.
