As I'm sure you know by now, all our donations go towards funding patient care and our internship programs; however, what does that mean? Many patients are low-income and cannot afford the costs associated with their care. This includes medications, copays, appointment costs, scans, and much more. In 2021, when we first became a nonprofit, we used \$711 to help cover 3 patients. Through fundraising efforts, we raised more funds through 2022 and were able to use \$3,912.76 to serve a total of 27 patients!

Our second mission is to mentor the next generation of geriatricians and a diverse group of physicians. There is a shortage of geriatric physicians and we aim to foster an interest in the field through meaningful interactions. Our internship program is currently mostly unpaid so our interns have to balance school, the internship, a job, volunteering, and research. By getting paid, they can spend more time in the office as they can get paid and earn clinical hours and even get research experience all in one place. This allows them to spend more time in our office and become more exposed to how enriching it is being a geriatrician and serving your community. In 2022, one intern went on to pursue a degree in surgical technology, three interns moved on to pursuing Master's Degrees, three interns went on to apply to PA school, two interns were accepted into research programs, two interns were accepted into PhD programs, and three interns were accepted into medical school.
